Do you still tip when there is a \$2 delivery charge? In the years before the delivery charge started, the national chains had a mileage rate of 50 to 75 cents per delivery. Gas was less than \$1.50 a gallon. Today the mileage rate is about \$1.00 per delivery, and this is with a \$2-\$3 delivery charge.
